Summary:

The Teacher will provide participants with a daily and ongoing Life Skills program rooted in culture that will provide the best possible knowledge and skills needed to thrive as a healthy, young indigenous person. This program will be based on various

The teacher possesses a passion for teaching children who learn differently and may be responsible for up to 10-12 youth at any given time. The Teacher is responsible for designing a program under a cultural framework. The teacher collaborates with others to deliver instruction, assess and track progress.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Facilitation:

1. Prepare lessons, activities and approaches for the assigned time period.

2. Design lessons with an appropriate level of difficulty which provide content in cohesive manner, according to the framework of Nimkee Nupigawagan Healing Centre

3. Employ a variety of instructional techniques and media consistent with the physical limitations of the classroom and the needs and capabilities of the participants

4. Identify participant needs and provide instruction appropriate to those needs

5. Analyze and interpret student wellness and treatment plans to develop and modify activities.

6. Devise activities that use all senses of self that promotes wholistic well being.

7. Display knowledge of a subject matter and ensure effective time use.

Other Duties with Participants:

1. Encourage students to strive to meet their highest potential

2. Establish and communicate any rules, and encourage students to set and maintain standards of behavior

3. Engage youth in conversation to encourage development

4. Make provisions for being available to staff, participants and parents outside the hours when required or requested to do so under reasonable terms

5. Work to establish and maintain open lines of communication with staff and students. 6. Take all necessary and reasonable precautions to protect participants, equipment, materials, and facilities **Professional Contacts and Activities:**

1. Attend and participate in staff and Impact Team meetings

2. Participate in meetings at least once per intake with the case manager, parents, and other professional staff to review and revise the Treatment Plan

3. Keep immediate supervisor informed of activities and any issues that may arise

4. Cooperate with other members of the staff in planning instructional goals, curriculum, objectives, and methods

5. Provide needed and requested information on a timely and effective basis

6. Evaluate student progress on a regular basis.

- 7. Assist in the evaluation of students referred for special education services
- 8. Input data and evaluations in a timely fashion
- 9. May collaborate with other learning staff

10. Other duties as directed

Other:

1. Assist in upholding and adhering to policies and procedures.

2. Assume responsibility for his or her continuing professional growth and development

3. Adhere to The Code of Ethics of Nimkee Nupigawagan Healing Centre and any professional body.

4. Seek assistance should emergencies arise

- 6. Perform other duties as assigned
